FLAG DAY 2016



Today, Thursday, 3rd November 2016 marked a very special day not only for the UAE but for our Grade 3, 4, 5 and 6 students, as they were invited to a special Flag Day celebration in Zabeel Park with the presence of His Highness, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai. Over 1,000 of our ISC Dubai students departed the school at 8:30 AM and went by bus to Zabeel Park. The excitement was electric because not only were they going to see His Highness but all the students were allowed to skip classes, a very rare event for our academic students! Amongst the 20,000 students from schools all around Dubai, ISC Dubai and ISC DIP made up nearly 1,700 of those students. The celebration included forming the largest human flag with observers from the Guinness World Records present and a live broadcast by Dubai Television, along with regional and global television networks. Each student was given a hat that was either red, green, white or black to represent the UAE flag. His Highness Sheikh Mohammed arrived to the cheers of students and the national anthem was sung with pride as the UAE flag was raised. His Highness greeted selected students on stage and passed through the crowds of the 20,000 students as they flew their UAE flags. ISC Dubai students were delighted and appreciative to be included in this exclusive event. The morning turned out to be a success and further Flag Day celebrations were continued back in the school.
