

Absenteeism

Frequent unexcused absences negatively affect students' academic progress, social skills, and wellbeing. This includes Fridays, which remain full learning days despite shorter hours.

As per the KHDA Parent–School Contract:

- **Four incidents** of unexcused absenteeism in a short period: Written warning; absence recorded on the progress report.
- **+ Three additional incidents:** Meeting with the Principal (or delegate) and a signed attendance pledge; absence recorded on the progress report.
- **Further absences:** May lead to community service at school, detention, or temporary suspension.
- **Third and final warning:** The school may refuse re-enrolment for the following year.
